How to return your voting paper

28 May 2019

Please read carefully before voting!

This is a postal election. The voting papers must be returned in the addressed envelope provided, and only **one** voting paper goes in each envelope.

1. If posting your voting paper, you must use the enclosed envelope and post it to;

Your vote will **not** be counted **unless** the envelope is postmarked before noon, 7 June and received by the Returning Officer no later than 5 days after the date of the election.

Post as soon as possible – New Zealand Post has reduced the frequency of its mail delivery service.

2. Delivering your voting paper to the school.
Either:
 - a. Take to the school office where it will be placed in the voting box.
 - b. Place it in the school post box outside the school at 204 Selwyn Street

Whatever delivery option you take, ensure it is in the envelope with the Returning Officer's address on it and that it is done before:

Noon, 7 June 2019

All boxes will be cleared at noon on 7 June.
